Presentation "<u>Developing Resiliency in Kids</u>" by Veronique Lilienthal, Haycock ES counselor, and Kathleen Otal, McLean HS counselor

- Introduction: Inspirational Video Lessons to be learned from Ollie, the dog.

- Develop coping skills: Allowing your kids to feel boredom and other uncomfortable feelings, allows them to grow in developing coping strategies.
- Build emotional resiliency: Students are developing important social skills at these young ages
- Reviewed the Problem-Solving Model
  - 1. What is the problem?
  - 2. What have you done to solve it?
  - 3. What else can you do?
  - 4. What is the best solution?
  - 5. Afterwards How did that work?
- 2 role playing scenarios demonstrated the Problem-Solving Model
  - O Mother and son Johnny discuss Johnny's disappointment at school. Johnny did not finish his math work in the allotted time, so he had to miss story time to complete his work.
  - Scenario 1: Parent Intervention Mother contacts teacher to complain that Johnny missed story time with the rest of the class.
  - Scenario 2: Problem-Solving Model Mother and Johnny use the 5 questions to guide a discussion for Johnny to identify the problem and identify solutions and then pick the best solution for the problem
- Problem-solving expectations for students at school:
  - O The student talks with the teacher.
  - O The student talks with the counselor.
  - Only if necessary, the parent becomes directly involved in problem-solving. Parents act as coaches or cheerleaders while allowing students to self-advocate.
