- V. Guest speaker: Mary Smith, Parenting coach and Consultant
 - Topic: Limits, boundaries and consequences
 - How to build a connection while holding boundaries
 - Objective: Give kids the opportunity to make their own choice within the limits of boundaries we set
 - Two types of consequences:
 - I. Logical- require intervention of an adult or other children (family meeting).
 - a. 4R's- related to the antecedent, reasonable, respectful, and revealed in advance
 - b. Logical consequences work but only when done well. Not the first thing she goes to
 - II. Natural- anything that happens naturally with no adult interference. Excellent for long term success. Impersonal. You don't have to be as involved or make up a consequence
